For the month of September we have done a Round Up in stores to support both Mission 22 and Warriors Heart. But that's not all! Fresh Thyme hosted our 3rd annual Fresh Thyme Giving Tree Golf Classic on September 20th at Cog Hill Country Club in Lemont, IL. All of our proceeds are benefitting Mission 22 and Warriors Heart. We are very proud to support our veterans and help spread the message that we are losing our veterans, the men and women who are fighting to keep our daily freedom, to suicide. Both Mission 22 and Warriors Heart have fantastic programs for veterans and their families. With our support and donation, we are able to save lives and give back to those who fought for us.

This is our first year doing the Round Up and our third Golf Classic. This year the Round Up generated a HUGE donation of \$178,969.89! That donation is only generated from our customers "rounding up" and donating their change. What a donation! Thank you to every employee who rounded up on their own Fresh Thyme purchases and thank you to each of you who talked about Mission 22 and Warriors Heart with our customers. A special shout out to our top 3 stores for the round up, very nice work! The third highest donation, totaling at \$4,036.34, was from our round up was from store #309, Westerville –nice work! The second highest donation, totaling at \$4,023.35, was from store #609, North Canton—good job! And the highest donation, totaling at \$5,972.72, was from store #605, Farmington—way to take the lead on this!

It is impressive to watch our donations grow each year and exciting to see just how impactful a cause such as this is to our vendor partners. After our 2nd Golf Classic (last year!), Gallo Wine was so moved by the stories shared by veterans and what our donation of proceeds was able to do to help, they took it open themselves to create a program benefitting Mission 22. The program was scheduled to run through Thanksgiving or until they reached the \$5,000 donation mark. We saw our customers not only help with our Round Up but also took to this program and we reached the \$5,000 donation mark after only 3 weeks of the program! 
